SANDWICHES

Campo’s and Sonny’s Famous Steaks, both on Market Street, are known for their cheesesteaks.

CASUAL DINING

Breakfast, lunch and dinner are casual yet refined at nearby **High Street on Market**. Also laid back but stylish: bring-your-own-bottle (BYOB) spot **Chlœ** for New American cuisine, **Han Dynasty** for extra-spicy contemporary Chinese dishes and **Farmicia** for local and organic fare. Also great: **Capofitto** for great pizza and gelato and Society Hill’s **Puyero** for Venezuelan arepas.

GASTROPUBS

“Top Chef” Nick Elmi is behind the stylishly delicious **Royal Boucherie**. The historic **Khyber Pass Pub** does Southern and vegan too, with a great beer list. **The Gaslight** offers clever twists on classic dishes.

OUTDOOR DINING & DRINKING

When the weather warms up, the spots to go include the lovingly planted **Talula’s Garden**; spacious and fun **Independence Beer Garden** (across the street from the Liberty Bell); the rooftops of the **Revolution House** or Hotel Monaco (**Stratus Lounge**); and **La Peg’s** French-touched outdoor bar. Trendy **Morgan’s Pier**, with cutting-edge fare, great drinks and DJs, and the deck of **The Moshulu**, a vintage ship-turned-restaurant, are both on the Delaware River.

COFFEE & TREATS

Lines out the door and ice cream floats are the order of every day at Victorian-inspired **Franklin Fountain**. The house specialties at **ICI Macarons & Cafe** are airy French pastries. Tiny **Tartes** specializes in homey desserts to go. Great coffee stops include Church Street’s **Old City Coffee**, serene **Bodhi** and modern **Menagerie Coffee**.
